

philosophy on raising animals

We believe that animals should be allowed to live as naturally as possible. We confine them as necessary to protect them from predators and from traffic, but all of our animals have room to move and a chance to forage foods from our fields, brush and woods, which have not been treated with chemical fertilizers.

We feed all of our animals natural grains without antibiotics, plus scrap produce from local businesses. Most of our grains are milled in New England.

We process our chickens ourselves, and our larger animals are butchered at USDA facilities.

American Guinea hogs are an endangered farm animal. They are great foragers. They are small (our largest boar is approximately 300 pounds) and easy to handle.

After raising Cornish Crosses and experimenting with other breeds, we have chosen to raise **Freedom Rangers**. This breed was developed for the French "slow food" movement. They grow more slowly than the Cornish Crosses, but have fewer health problems, are more pleasant to work with and taste better, especially when they can forage for bugs and plants for a significant part of their diet. We raise ours on pasture protected by electric netting.

When we decided we would add pigs to our farm to help us reclaim overgrown areas, we were delighted to find a heritage breed, American Guinea Hogs, which are smaller than commercial hogs, and well suited to forage feeding. They are a perfect hog for a small operation, and their meat is more flavorful than grocery store pork. Our USDA processed cuts range from \$5 to \$9 a pound, with a discount for purchases over 15 pounds.

We raise mixed-breed sheep with an increasing percentage of Polypay, a breed developed to be raised on grass. Our sheep help us keep our pastures clear through rotational grazing in temporary electric fencing. Our USDA processed cuts range from \$9 to \$12 a pound with a discount for purchases over 15 pounds.
